Starting in 2008 the Department of Education changed the collection and reporting of race/ethnicity. Two new categories were added and students were able to select multiple values. For reporting, students who indicate a Hispanic background are reported as Hispanic (even if other values are also reported). Student who are not Hispanic but report multiple race values are reported in the "2 or more races" category. Students who are not Hispanic and report a single race are reported in the single race category. Prior to 2008, only a single race/ethnic value was collected and used in reporting. Comparisons before and after 2008 are not meaningful.
