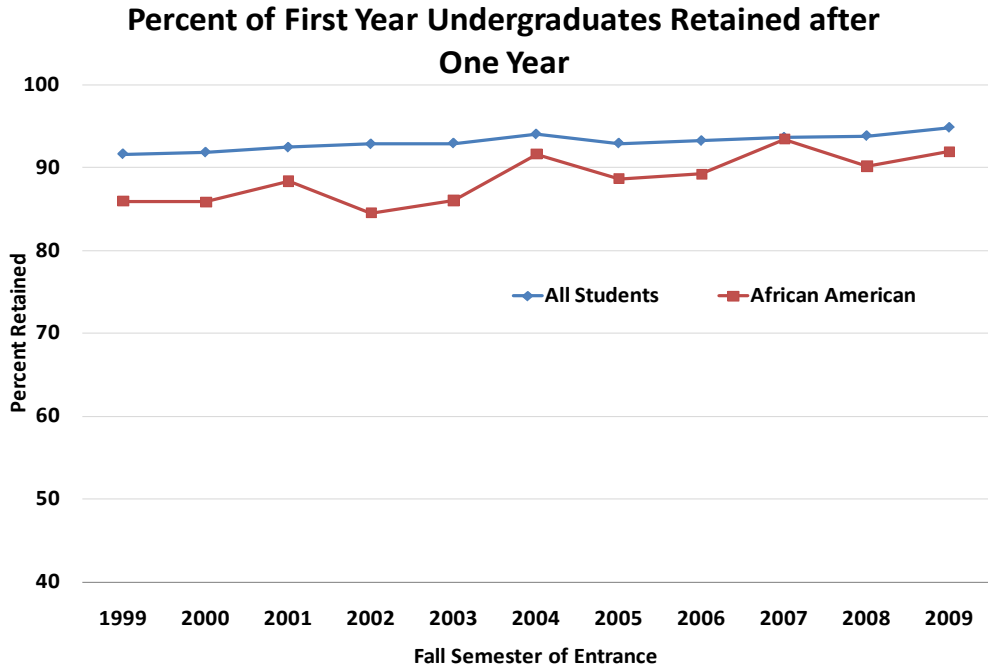

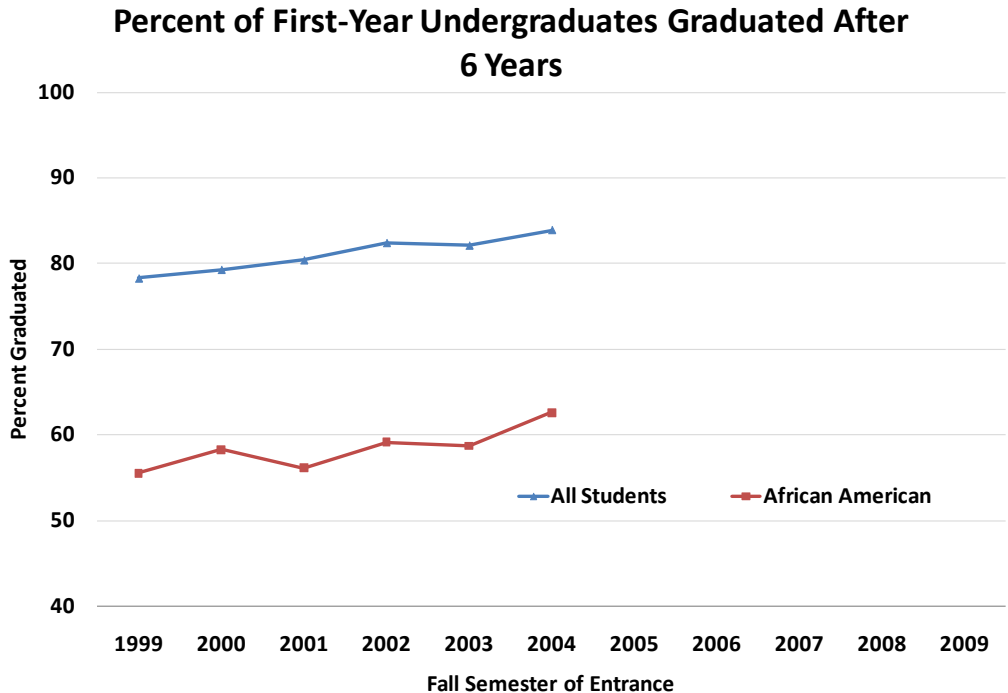

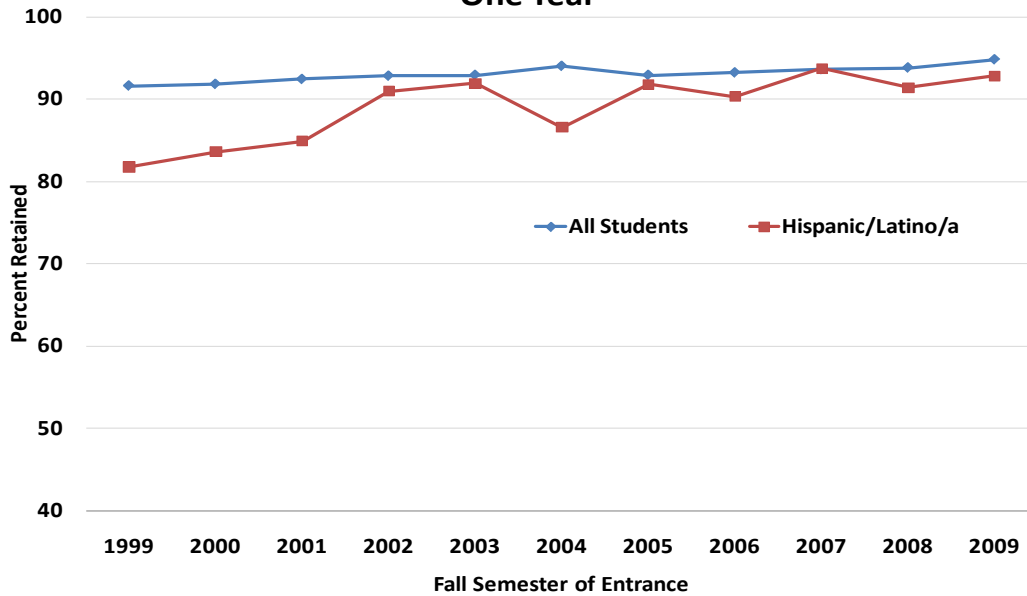

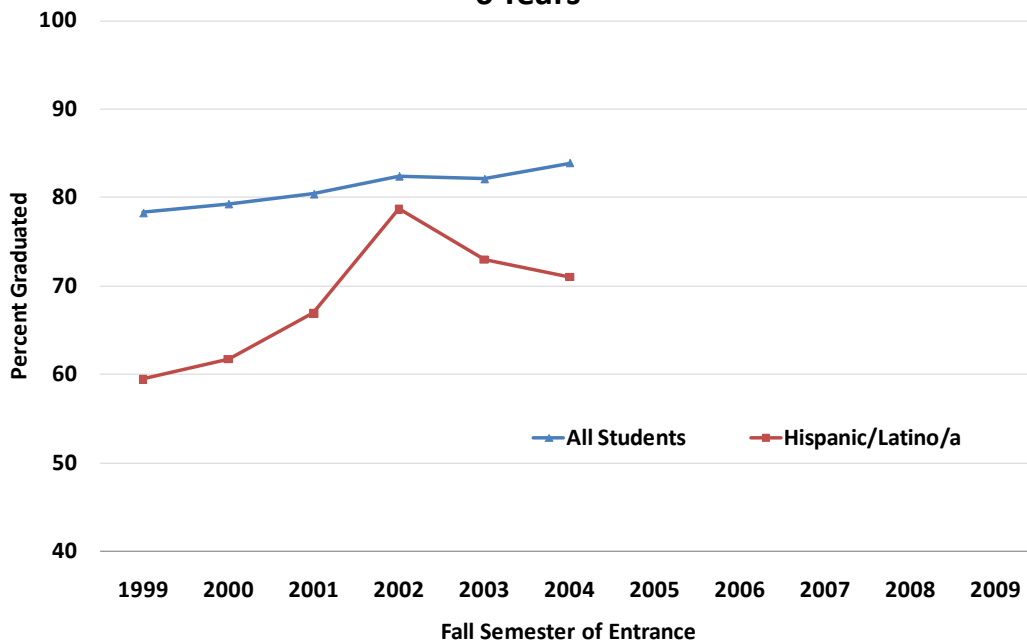

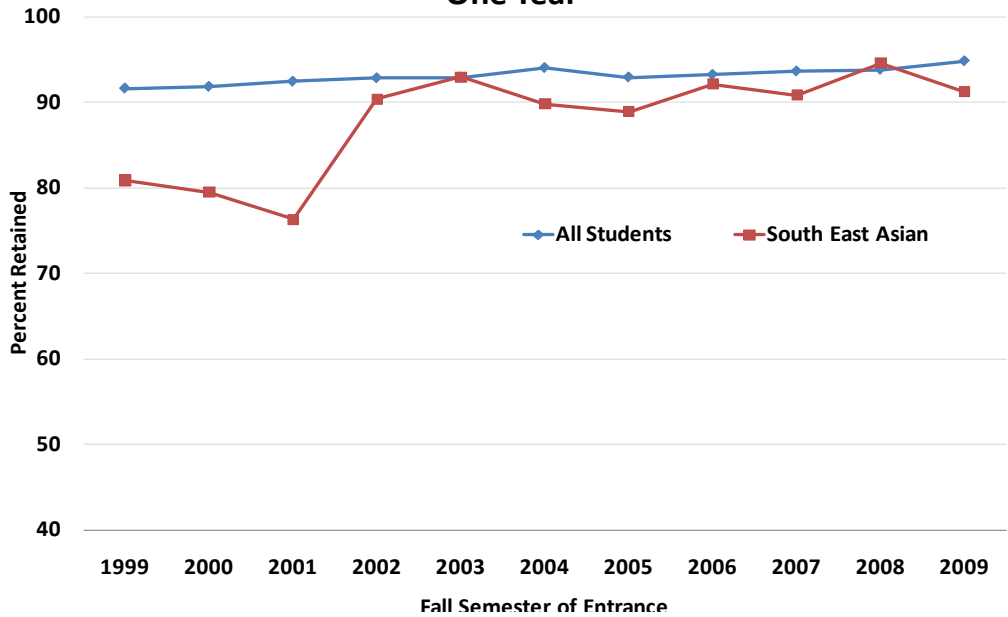

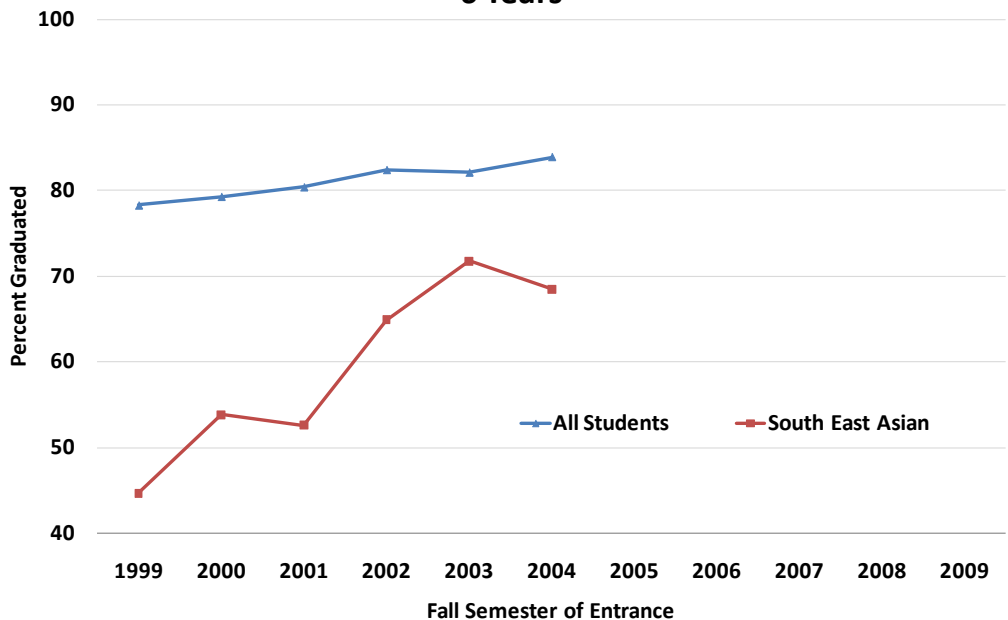
Retention: South East Asians

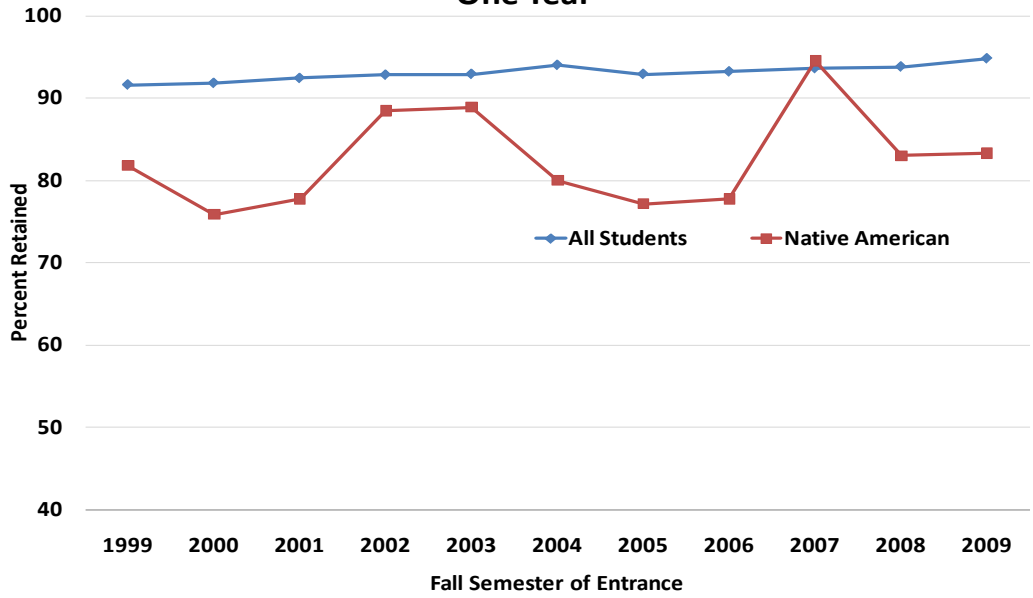

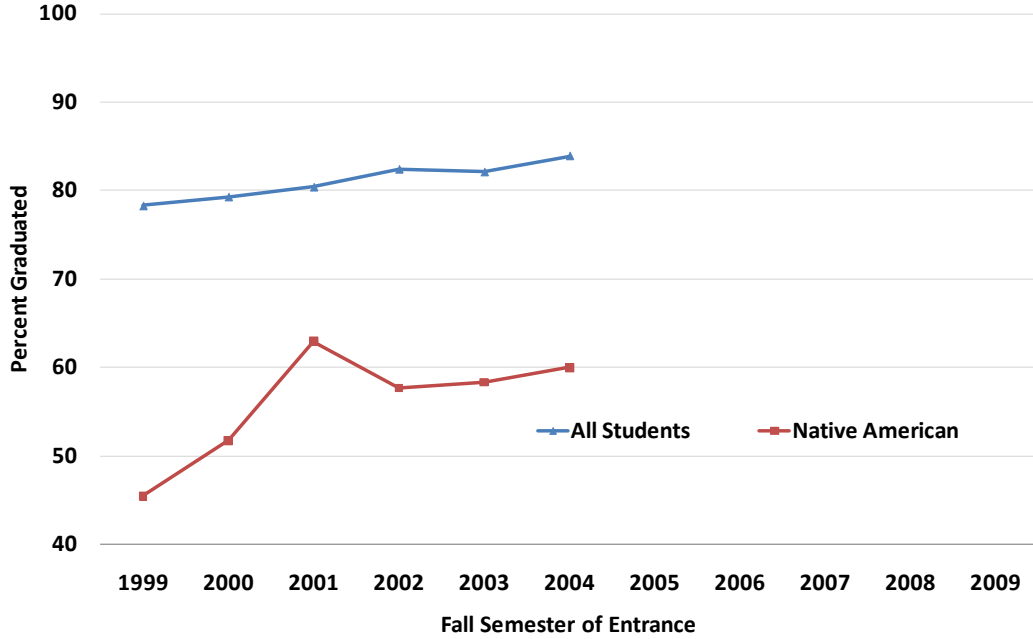
